2025: A Year of Momentum

In 2025, voters successfully defeated the largest tax-increase referendum in township history. This achievement was driven by a 5% increase in voter turnout and significant growth in our party. Registered Republicans now exceed 7,000, bringing us within 200 voters of the current number of registered Democrats. Additionally, our contact list and newsletter readership have reached record levels, allowing us to connect with more neighbors than ever before.

Looking to 2026

To build on this momentum, continued volunteer involvement and donor support are essential. Our key priorities for the coming year include voter registration, election support activities, and preparing for upcoming township and school district races.

Did You Know?

- Montgomery County comprises 25 local towns and boroughs, each with its own elected officials.
- Candidates typically invest approximately \$8,000 in campaign expenses for these local offices and we could use your donation help to support
- Upper Providence elections are often decided by narrow margins. Statewide, fewer than 50,000 votes can determine Pennsylvania's outcomes, underscoring the vital importance of local participation.
